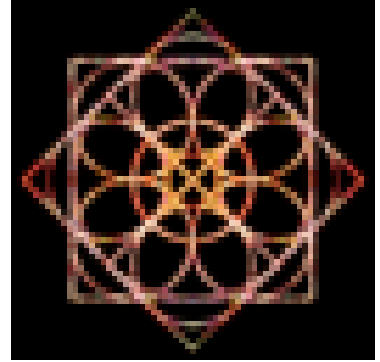

Two Apprenticeship Programs And Special Classes as Announced

Apprenticeship Programs

Keeper of the Water Ceremonies Apprenticeship

Being called to become a Keeper is great honor and responsibility, therefore, requirements of apprenticeship for offering the Full Moon Ceremony, and Rites of Passages for baby girls and girls at menses include:

- Begin by attending three Full Moon Water Ceremonies In-Person or Telephone. See the New Dream Foundation Calendar for times and locations.
- Learn Step 1 of the Creation Meditation and share experiences at the New Dream Foundation Forum. (The forum provides the steps written out and available as an mp3.)
- **To apply for Water Ceremony Apprenticeship**, send an e-mail expressing your desire to be a Keeper of the Water Ceremonies to Cindy Mills, discussing why you feel called to become a Keeper at HelpingHands@NewDreamFoundation.com.
- Attend monthly pre-apprenticeship training calls. (A donation of \$15 per month will be requested.)
- Participate in The Secret Art of Ceremony Class offered in September—active participation required. This class is announced in August when you sign up to be on the Foundation mailing list.

- Continue learning Step 2 and 3 of the Creation Meditation at the New Dream Forum and share experiences at the Forum.
- Create your regalia, bowl and talking stick; preparing for initiation at SpiritQuest.
- Offer 6-9 Full Moon Water Ceremonies prior to SpiritQuest at the end of June
- Attend SpiritQuest in June for your initiation at the ancient water bowl as a Keeper of the Water Ceremonies, performed by Reverend Misa, the Guardian of the Water Bowl Ceremonies. (This requirement can be waived for apprentices living outside the U.S.)

Initiation for offering Womanhood or Elderhood Rites of Passage through the Water Ceremonies requires additional apprenticeship and is discussed with you after completion of this first initiation.

Ministerial Training Apprenticeship

Ministerial training is for those called to ministry as a major part of your life purpose. Training helps you prepare for a life of ministry and service in alignment with your specific calling. All spiritual traditions and newly created traditions are honored.

The participant will have the opportunity to create a ministerial program of their own with approval from an advisory board/council of their choosing. It is up to the participant to develop an apprenticeship proposal for presentation and acceptance by Reverend Misa and the participant's advisory council.

The following are highly recommended elements for apprenticeship. Previous experience will be considered. Many of these requirements can be completed in combination. Special requirements may be considered appropriate for specific types of ministerial service. (For example someone who wishes to lead quests will probably be asked to complete more than one quest for themselves.)

- Completion of selected and approved classes of your choice; offered through New Dream Foundation or other individuals or organizations
- Mentorship with Misa
- Service Project – created by the apprentice, in keeping with the apprentice's ministerial calling, with oversight by the advisory council

- Sacred Site Visitation – site selected, purpose approach created by the apprentice with oversight by the advisory council
- Quest–Vision, Song, Ayawaska, 24 hour sweat lodge, firewalk, burial, elderhood for example
- Participate in a week-long ceremony, meditation, or pilgrimage (can be your own quest or participation at SpiritQuest; or with a sacred site visit)
- Spiritual Counseling Project – Includes guidance and practice in counseling a member of your community; as well as a 1 year minimum of personal spiritual counseling for the ministerial training student.
- Application for ministerial certification for Ordination and Ordination Ceremony

To apply for Ministerial Apprenticeship, send a letter to Reverend Misa discussing why you feel called to become a minister through New Dream Foundation.
